This infrastructure development partnership needs two remarkable and enthusiastic people to ensure this exciting three year programme reaches its full potential.

Funded through BIG; the programme has Merseyside Disability Federation as lead body, and together with Access Lancashire, Breakthrough UK, Cumbria Disability Network, Disability Information Bureau and Warrington Disability Partnership we make up the North West Disability Infrastructure Partnership.

Our **Partnership Coordinator** will need to understand disability equality and appreciate the complexities facing the voluntary and community sector and also understand the nature of effective infrastructure support.

Our **Information and Outreach Officer** will have experience of actively promoting equality of opportunity and a broad understanding of the needs of voluntary and community groups.

Both posts require excellent interpersonal and written communication skills, great time management and personal organisation capability and a commitment to the core values of MDF – Equity, Trust, Accountability and Innovation.

Both posts are full time and run until September 2012. Based with the core MDF team in Liverpool City Centre and working across the North West, there will be some scope for remote/home working. Annual holiday entitlement is 25 days plus 8 public holidays and 2 additional days. Each post attracts a 5% pension contribution and will offer ongoing opportunities for continuous professional development.
