Aim

To increase participants' understanding of Gypsy, Roma and Traveller communities, their history and culture and the discrimination they face.

Learning Objectives

By the end of the training participants will be able to:

- Describe some important elements of Gypsy, Roma and Traveller history and culture and consider how to celebrate these
- Recognise public prejudice and stereotypes facing Gypsies, Roma and Travellers.
- Identify the issues facing Gypsy, Roma and Traveller children and young people
- Describe the major barriers preventing Gypsy, Roma and Traveller people from accessing key services and identify strategies to overcome these

Outcomes

Through engaging with Gypsy, Roma and Traveller culture and history, staff will therefore feel more confident in implementing the key principles of good practice in working with Gypsy, Roma and Traveller communities.

Who should attend

This training is suitable for delegates who already, or may in future, come into contact with members of Gypsy, Roma or Traveller communities. The training can also help organisations, with a statutory duty to include ethnic minorities, meet these requirements.
